

Michael Roubach (Hebrew University of Jerusalem): “Numbers as Ideal Species: Husserlian and Contemporary Perspectives”

In this paper I will provide an interpretation of Husserl’s position in his Logical Investigations based on Kit Fine’s defense of a Cantorian conception of natural number. Although Fine’s position is not explicitly an interpretation of Husserl’s conception of natural number and is not identical to it I will argue that it provides an excellent way to interpret Husserl’s position.
